Admisson to the library and browsing books and other items are free. The library is open to all people.

Registration

A library card (Toshokan card) is required to borrow books.

The library card is free for anyone who lives, works or attends school in Kamisu City. To obtain a library card, fill out an application form and present your ID with your name and present address (ID example: driver's license, health insurance certificate, student ID).

The library card can be used at Kamisu branch libraries.

Let us know if you lose your card or you have changed your name, address, or telephone number.

Library cards are valid for three years and can be renewed at the library.

Library cards are not transferable and may be used only by the individual indicated. The library may not give information about your library record and privacy information to anyone but you.

Borrowing

You can borrow library materials at the counter using your library card.

Returning

To return the materials, bring them to the counter. A library card is not necessary. You can return your items to any library location.

If the library is closed, return them to the book drop in front of the library.

If an item is damaged or lost, you are responsible for the cost of the item.

Finding books

The library computers are available to search for materials.

You may place requests for cheked-out materials at the counter or access our online catalog, via the liblary website. A password is needed to access your account.

Using audio-visual booth

Audio-visual booth are set up for viewing video materials (DVD, VHS and laserdisc) and listening to CD and cassette tape. A library card is necessary. It is available only once a day.

^{*2} Materials with request may not be renewed.

Keep your cell phones on silent mode and use them only in the lounge and entrance. Eating and drinking are prohibited in the reading room.

Photography is not allowed on library premises without prior permission.
